We are currently seeking approximately 35 volunteers to assist during the match on September 18–19, 2026, in Vienna.

As a Davis Cup volunteer, you will support the organizers in specific areas and experience the event at the Wiener Athletiksport Club from a unique perspective. You will have the chance to take a look behind the scenes of one of the most important team competitions in international men's tennis.

Davis Cup volunteers must be at least 18 years old and available to work full days on both Friday, September 18, and Saturday, September 19.

Volunteers will receive a uniform, and meals will be provided on-site.

Areas of Work:

- Spectator Service (Grand Stand): 18–20 volunteers
 - Seating and directing spectators in the stands.
 - Admission control at the grandstand entrances in accordance with official tennis rules (access only during changeovers/set breaks, etc.).
 - Ensuring peace and order in the spectator area during rallies
- Court Runners: 2–4 volunteers
 - Setting up player benches: Stocking the courts with towels and refreshments before the match.
 - Ball logistics: Providing and restocking the official tournament balls on the court.
 - Quick match changeover: Promptly clearing and cleaning the player benches after the match ends.
- Court maintenance: 2–4 volunteers
 - Requirement: You enjoy playing on clay yourself, and raking the court after a match is routine for you.
 - Court maintenance during changeovers and after matches: Raking the court with a drag net and cleaning the lines.
 - Watering the court: Targeted watering of the clay court as coordinated with the umpire.
- Media and office support: 2–4 volunteers
 - Press assistance: Actively supporting the press officer directly in the media center
 - Back-Office Runner: Quickly run errands on the venue
 - Flexible on-call assignments: Providing short-notice assistance at various stations during staffing shortages.

- Beverage Service: 2-3 volunteers
 - On-Site Supply: Delivering beverages to all offices and official stations
 - Fridges Management: Regularly restock all fridges for players, staff, and VIP areas
 - Empty bottle logistics: Collecting returnable bottles and properly sorting empty bottles in the warehouse
 - Inventory control: Monitoring stock levels and promptly reporting shortages to logistics management.

- Friday, September 18: from 9:00 a.m. (VOL training) until the end of the last match (approx. 9:00 p.m.)
- Saturday, September 19: from 9:30 a.m. until the end of the last match (approx. 9:00 p.m. if there are three games)
